Community Hospital provides *Regional Healthcare Excellence* to more than 30,000 people who live in SW Nebraska and NW Kansas. A critical access facility, Community Hospital excels in surgery care, inpatient care, cancer services, emergency care, and in offering a wide range of visiting specialists. With a dedication to providing quality, efficient and patient-centered services, Community Hospital opened a \$29 million 25-bed patient wing with all-private rooms in January 2011. A new surgery wing was completed in May 2012. The Anderson Center for Radiation Oncology was completed in April 2014. Construction began in 2019 to construct a new Cardiopulmonary Rehabilitation Center and Medical Specialists Center.
